ANNOUNCEMENT FOR GREEK LANGUAGE EXAMINATIONS

This announcement refers to individuals who <u>DO NOT</u> participate in the lessons provided by the Modern Greek Language Teaching Centre but wish to participate in the May and/or September 2017 examinations in order to acquire the Certificate of Greek Language Knowledge

Required documents:

- 1. <u>Application form</u> (found in the main webpage of the Modern Greek Language Teaching Centre). Submitted ONLY electronically, printed out and handed in with the other documents
- 2. Photocopy of High School Diploma or University Degree, verified for the authenticity of the title by a Greek Diplomatic authority abroad or by the Diplomatic authority of the foreigner's country in Greece or stamped with the Apostille seal in accordance with the Hague Convention (see appendix) and officially translated into Greek by a Greek Diplomatic authority abroad or by the Translation Services of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (10 Arionos str., tel.: 2102103285755-7) or by a lawyer with verification by the Lawyers' Bar
- 3. Photocopy of passport. Moreover, for those who originate from countries which are not members of the European Union, a photocopy of the residency permit which is valid until the completion of the exams
- 4. The original bank receipt of payment of tuition fees at Alpha Bank (account no. 802002001000227) and a photocopy of the receipt
- 5. One photo

Tuition fees: Individuals who participate in May or September examinations for the first time should pay 80,00 €. Those who failed the May examinations and wish to be re-examined in September should pay 50,00 €

General Information:

- 1. The Greek Language Knowledge Certificate can only be obtained through the successful participation in both the oral and written examinations
- 2. Only those who have participated in the oral examinations may also participate in the written examinations
- 3. Candidates who are taking part in the examinations (oral and written) must bring their student card AND their passport or identity card
- 4. On the day of the written examination, only the main entrance of the School of Philosophy situated on the second floor will be open
- 5. Candidates who do not pass the May examinations may participate in the September examinations as long as they register at the Secretariat and submit their student card, a photocopy of it, the original bank receipt and a photocopy of it on the registration dates of the September examinations
- 6. Candidates who do not pass the May examinations and wish to participate in the Summer Course of the Greek Language Teaching Centre may register ONLY on Friday 2nd of June 2017 (for information on the Summer Course: The Secretariat of the Modern Greek Language Teaching Centre or www.greekcourses.uoa.gr).

- The written examinations will be held on Saturday, 27th of May 2017 in the amphitheatres of the School of Philosophy. Candidates must be at the School of Philosophy by 08:15 a.m. The examinations will begin at 09:00 a.m. A list consisting of the name of each candidate and the corresponding amphitheatre where the examination will be held, will be pinned on the bulletin board which is situated outside the Secretariat's office and on the doors of the main entrance of the School of Philosophy which is on the second floor
