<b>ECTS credits</b>	All students may participate in the end of each semester progress test. However, of the students who have passed the test, <b>ONLY</b> those that have attended at least 80% of the lessons, as indicated by the register of attendance, will be awarded ECTS credits Number of ECTS credits awarded: 6 per semester	
<b>Tuition fees</b>	Erasmus students from the University of Athens <b>DO NOT</b> need to pay the fees All the other Erasmus students from Greek Universities or Technical Colleges must pay 210,00 € per semester
