

## ANNOUNCEMENT FOR GREEK LANGUAGE EXAMINATIONS

This announcement refers to students who participate in the lessons provided by the Modern Greek Language Teaching Center and wish to participate in the May and/or September 2021 examinations in order to acquire the Certificate of Greek Language Knowledge

### Required documents:

Students who wish to participate in the examinations must register during the registration dates by sending an email to the Secretariat ([info@greekcourses.uoa.gr](mailto:info@greekcourses.uoa.gr)) with the following documents attached:

1. Their student card (received from the Secretariat by appointment)
2. Bank receipt of payment deposited at Alpha Bank in account no. 802002001000227 of the Special Account for Research Grants of the University of Athens (IBAN GR0301408020802002001000227)

**Tuition fees:** 60,00 € will be paid by students who participate in the May or September examinations for the first time. 40,00 € will be paid by those who failed the May examinations and wish to be re-examined in September

### General Information:

1. The Greek Language Certificate can only be obtained through the successful participation of a student in both the oral and written examinations
2. Students who are taking part in the examinations (oral and written) must bring their student card AND their passport or identity card
3. On the day of the written examination, only the main entrance of the School of Philosophy situated on the second floor will be open (all other entrances will be closed)
4. Students who do not pass the May examinations may participate in the September examinations as long as they register by sending an email to the Secretariat with their student card and receipt of payment attached during the registration dates of the September examinations
5. For the duration of the written and oral examinations, candidates are obliged to wear a face mask and gloves. Additionally, social distancing of 1,5-2 meters must be practiced
6. Communication with the Secretariat may ONLY take place by telephone or via email
7. The right to take part in the examinations will be confirmed by an email sent by the Secretariat after the documents have been checked. Additional information concerning the number of the amphitheatre of the School of Philosophy where the written examinations will take place, the exact date, time and room number of the Modern Greek Language Teaching Center for the oral examinations will also be sent
8. For ease of reference of the participants, the list of names and the number of the amphitheatres where the written examinations will take place will be posted in the main entrance of the second floor of the School of Philosophy. For the oral examinations the names of the participants and the room numbers will be posted in the entrance of the Modern Greek Language Teaching Center
9. Students who do not pass the May examinations and wish to participate in the Summer Course of the Greek Language Teaching Center may register ONLY on Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> of May 2021 (for information on the Summer Course: The Secretariat of the Modern Greek Language Teaching Center or [www.greekcourses.uoa.gr](http://www.greekcourses.uoa.gr))
10. All participants in the examinations must be fully informed about the safety measures and precautions prescribed by the Ministry of Health and the Ministry of Citizen Protection

## MAY EXAMINATIONS 2021

**Registration period:** Tuesday, 4<sup>th</sup> until Wednesday, 12<sup>th</sup> of May 2021

**Dates of examinations:**

- The oral examinations will be held from Monday 17<sup>th</sup> until Thursday, 20<sup>th</sup> of May 2021 (depending on the number of participants) in the classrooms of the Modern Greek Language Teaching Center. As a safety precaution, entrance to the Modern Greek Language Teaching Center will only be permitted 5 minutes before the predetermined time for the examination
- The written examinations will be held on Saturday, 22<sup>nd</sup> of May 2021 in the amphitheatres of the School of Philosophy. Time of arrival: 08:15 a.m. until 08:50 a.m. After the time of arrival, all the entrances will be locked. Start time for examination: 09:00 a.m.

- The written examinations will be held on Saturday, 11<sup>th</sup> of September 2021 in the amphitheatres of the School of Philosophy. Time of arrival: 08:15 a.m. until 08:50 a.m. After the time of arrival, all the entrances will be locked. Start time for examination: 09:00 a.m.
