

ANNOUNCEMENT FOR GREEK LANGUAGE EXAMINATIONS

This announcement refers to individuals who DO NOT participate in the lessons provided by the Modern Greek Language Teaching Center but wish to participate in the May and/or September 2021 examinations in order to acquire the Certificate of Greek Language Knowledge

Required documents:

1. [Application form](#) (found in the main webpage of the Modern Greek Language Teaching Center)
2. High School Diploma or University Degree, verified for the authenticity of the title by a Greek Diplomatic authority abroad or by the Diplomatic authority of the foreigner's country in Greece or stamped with the Apostille seal in accordance with the Hague Convention ([see appendix](#)) and officially translated into Greek by a Greek Diplomatic authority abroad or by the Translation Services of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (10 Arionos str., tel.: 2102103285755-7) or by a lawyer with verification by the Lawyers' Bar
3. Passport or ID card for European Union citizens
4. Bank receipt of payment deposited at Alpha Bank in account no. 802002001000227 of the Special Account for Research Grants of the University of Athens (IBAN GR0301408020802002001000227)
5. One photo

Tuition fees: 80,00 € will be paid by individuals who participate in the May or September examinations for the first time. 50,00 € will be paid by those who failed the May examinations and wish to be re-examined in September

General Information:

1. The Greek Language Certificate can only be obtained through the successful participation of a student in both the oral and written examinations
2. Participants in the examinations will be issued with a card by the Secretariat with all their personal details (name, surname and photo). The card will be received by the participant following an appointment set via email with the Secretariat. All participants must have this card AND their passport or identity card with them for both the oral and written examinations
3. On the day of the written examination, only the main entrance of the School of Philosophy situated on the second floor will be open (all other entrances will be closed)
4. Candidates who do not pass the May examinations and wish to participate in the September examinations will have to send an email to the Secretariat during the registration dates for the September examinations, attaching the card issued by the Modern Greek Language Teaching Centre and the receipt of payment
5. For the duration of the written and oral examinations, participants are obliged to wear face masks and gloves. Additionally, social distancing of 1,5-2 meters must be practiced
6. Communication with the Secretariat may ONLY take place by telephone or via email
7. The right to take part in the examinations will be confirmed by an email sent by the Secretariat after the documents have been checked. Additional information concerning the number of the amphitheatre of the School of Philosophy where the written examinations will take place, the exact date, time and room number of the Modern Greek Language Teaching Center for the oral examinations will also be sent
8. For ease of reference of the participants, the list of names and the number of amphitheatres where the written examinations will take place will be posted in the main entrance of the second floor of the School of Philosophy. For the oral examinations the names of the participants and the room numbers will be posted in the entrance of the Modern Greek Language Teaching Center
9. Students who do not pass the May examinations and wish to participate in the Summer Course of the Greek Language Teaching Center may register ONLY on Thursday 27th of May 2021 (for information on the Summer Course: The Secretariat of the Modern Greek Language Teaching Center or www.greekcourses.uoa.gr)

- The oral examinations will be held from Monday 17th until Thursday, 20th of May 2021 (depending on the number of participants) in the classrooms of the Modern Greek Language Teaching Center. As a safety precaution, entrance to the Modern Greek Language Teaching Center will only be permitted 5 minutes before the predetermined time for the examination
- The written examinations will be held on Saturday, 22nd of May 2021 in the amphitheatres of the School of Philosophy. Time of arrival: 08:15 a.m. until 08:50 a.m. After the time of arrival, all the entrances will be locked. Start time for examination: 09:00 a.m.

- The written examinations will be held on Saturday, 11th of September 2021 in the amphitheatres of the School of Philosophy. Time of arrival: 08:15 a.m. until 08:50 a.m. After the time of arrival, all the entrances will be locked. Start time for examination: 09:00 a.m.
