**General information**

- Class attendance is compulsory. All students may participate in the end of year progress test. However, of the students who have passed the test, **ONLY** those that have attended at least 80% of the lessons, as indicated by the daily register of attendance, will be awarded ECTS credits in accordance with the duration of the course.
- Regular attendance is compulsory for all scholarship holders.
- A student may request that a certificate of registration, certificate of attendance and ECTS certificate be issued.
- The changing of classes and/or time of lessons will only be permitted if a place is available in the class the student wishes to enter and only if the Secretariat has been informed. The teacher of the class the student was initially enrolled in must be present when the student informs the Secretariat no later than the first week of classes.
- Students who wish to participate in the May 2023 examinations, will have to register from the 17<sup>th</sup> of April up to and including the 3<sup>rd</sup> of May 2023. Those who wish to participate in the September 2023 examinations, will have to register from the 3<sup>rd</sup> up to and including the 19<sup>th</sup> of July 2023 (relevant announcements will be given closer to the time). Students who participate in the May or September examinations for the first time should pay 70,00 €. Those who failed the May examinations and wish to be re-examined in September should pay 50,00 €. Students who have not registered for the examinations will **NOT** be permitted to participate.
- Student fees are not refunded in case of cessation of studies or non attendance of lessons.
- The student card issued by the Modern Greek Language Teaching Centre **CANNOT** be used to purchase half price tickets for public transport. It may be used for discounted tickets in certain museums, cinemas and theatres as the case may be. In addition, upon presentation of the card, students can dine at the restaurant of the School of Philosophy at a cost of 4,00 € (lunch and dinner).
- Medical insurance booklets **CANNOT** be issued to students of the Modern Greek Language Teaching Centre. However, at the School of Philosophy, in case of emergency, medical services are available at the Infirmary (±50 m. from the Modern Greek Language Teaching Centre). On the premises of the School of Philosophy a photocopying centre, a restaurant and 3 canteens can be found.
- Within the Modern Greek Language Teaching Centre building smoking, eating and drinking (coffee, cold drinks, tea, fruit juices etc) is **NOT** permitted. Moreover, during teaching hours the use of mobile phones is **NOT** permitted. Students may **NOT** record, film or take pictures of the teacher or the white board during the lesson.
- The students must comply with Covid-19 related announcements.
