

## ANNOUNCEMENT FOR GREEK LANGUAGE EXAMINATIONS

This announcement refers to individuals who **DO NOT** participate in the lessons provided by the Modern Greek Language Teaching Center-Panagiotis Kontos but wish to participate in the May and/or September 2026 examinations in order to acquire the Certificate of Greek Language Knowledge

### Required documents (to be attached to the electronic application form):

1. [Application form](#) (found in the main webpage of the Modern Greek Language Teaching Center-Panagiotis Kontos)
2. High School Diploma or University Degree, verified for the authenticity of the title and officially translated into Greek ([see appendix](#)).
3. Passport or ID card for European Union citizens
4. Bank receipt of payment deposited at Alpha Bank in account no. 802002001000227 of the Special Account for Research Grants of the University of Athens (IBAN GR0301408020802002001000227)
5. One photo

**Tuition fees:** 90,00 € will be paid by individuals who participate in the May or September examinations for the first time. 60,00 € will be paid by those who failed the May examinations and wish to be re-examined in September

### General Information:

1. The Greek Language Certificate can only be obtained through the successful participation of a student in both the oral and written examinations
2. Participants in the examinations will be issued with a card by the Secretariat with all their personal details (name, surname and photo) and will be received from the Secretariat. All participants must have this card AND their passport or identity card with them for both the oral and written examinations
3. On the day of the written examination, only the main entrance of the School of Philosophy situated on the second floor will be open (all other entrances will be closed)
4. Candidates who do not pass the May examinations and wish to participate in the September examinations will have to register during the registration dates for the September examinations
5. The right to take part in the examinations will be confirmed by an email sent by the Secretariat after the documents have been checked. Additional information concerning the exact date, time and room number of the Modern Greek Language Teaching Center-Panagiotis Kontos for the oral examinations and the number of the amphitheater of the School of Philosophy where the written examinations will take place will also be sent
6. For ease of reference of the participants, their names and the room numbers will be posted in the entrance of the Modern Greek Language Teaching Center-Panagiotis Kontos for the oral examinations and the list of names and the number of amphitheaters where the written examinations will take place will be posted in the main entrance of the second floor of the School of Philosophy
7. Participants who do not pass the May examinations and wish to participate in the Summer Course of the Greek Language Teaching Center may register ONLY on Friday 29<sup>th</sup> of May 2026 (for information on the Summer Course: The Secretariat of the Modern Greek Language Teaching Center-Panagiotis Kontos or [www.greekcourses.uoa.gr](http://www.greekcourses.uoa.gr))

## **MAY EXAMINATIONS 2026**

**Registration period:** Monday, 6<sup>th</sup> of April until Wednesday, 22<sup>nd</sup> of April 2026

### **Dates of examinations:**

- The oral examinations will be held from Monday, 18<sup>th</sup> until Thursday, 21<sup>st</sup> of May 2026 (depending on the number of participants) in the classrooms of the Modern Greek Language Teaching Center-Panagiotis Kontos. Entrance to the Modern Greek Language Teaching Center-Panagiotis Kontos will only be permitted 5 minutes before the predetermined time for the examination
- The written examinations will be held on Saturday, 23<sup>rd</sup> of May 2026 in the amphitheatres of the School of Philosophy. Time of arrival: 08:15 a.m. until 08:50 a.m. After the time of arrival, all the entrances will be locked. Start time for examination: 09:00 a.m.

**Registration period:** Wednesday, 1<sup>st</sup> until Wednesday, 15<sup>th</sup> of July 2026

### **Dates of examinations:**

- The oral examinations will be held from Tuesday, 1<sup>st</sup> of September until Thursday, 3<sup>rd</sup> of September 2026 (depending on the number of participants) in the classrooms of the Modern Greek Language Teaching Center-Panagiotis Kontos. Entrance to the Modern Greek Language Teaching Center-Panagiotis Kontos will only be permitted 5 minutes before the predetermined time for the examination
- The written examinations will be held on Saturday, 5<sup>th</sup> of September 2026 in the amphitheatres of the School of Philosophy. Time of arrival: 08:15 a.m. until 08:50 a.m. After the time of arrival, all the entrances will be locked. Start time for examination: 09:00 a.m.
